

## Standard Show Rules for Dallas Dressage Club Schooling Show Series 2008.

- 1) **Entries:** All horses brought on the show grounds must have a completed entry form and be issued a number. Please fill out your entries in their entirety. Each class will be filled on a first-come-first-served basis. If the show is oversubscribed, a waiting list will be maintained. Post entries will be allowed on a space available first-come-first-served basis. There will be a limit of three rides per horse at training level and below, 2 rides in first level and above. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry, cancel, combine or make any changes it deems necessary. Show management request that competitors follow USEF/USDF rules as closely as possible. Schooling attire is encouraged, but proper headgear and footwear is mandatory. Protective boots and polos are allowed.
- 2) **Official Ride Times:** Ride times will be posted by 12 noon the day before the show. It is the rider's responsibility to check their official ride times for changes upon their arrival at the show. It is the rider's responsibility to inform the Management of any time conflicts at least 12 hours before the scheduled ride. Classes may be out of order. Failure to enter the arena at the specified time will result in elimination.
- 3) **Scratches and Changes:** The show office must be notified of all scratches. Not showing up for your scheduled time is disrespectful and abuse of this policy will not be tolerated. Do not make your scratches at the paddock gate. Rides can only be changed if there is an available scratch in the class. All changes must be done at the office and paid for at the time of the change. Changes are \$10 each occurrence. Change slips will be provided which must be handed to the Paddock Master. Change slips will identify entrant's #, added class/ride, eliminated class/ride, and paid fee. All numbers on horses must match at all times and be reflected accurately on change slips. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to reflect any changes to the paddock master, and provide change slip as noted above to paddock master. .
- 4) **Coggins test:** Negative Coggins within the past 12 months is required. Failure to enclose a copy with entry or present it on the day of the show will result in elimination without return of fees. Original Coggins must be available for inspection during the show. Competition Management will assume no responsibility for the health of horses being stabled. Owners are warned they enter horses at their own risk.
- 5) **Refund Policy:** Before the closing date, all fees except the office fee will be refunded upon request. After the Closing Date, only stall and shavings fees will be refunded. No cancellations due to weather. Refunds will be mailed within 30 days of the show. No refunds will be made at the show. If there is a waiting list you may have your class fees refunded.
- 6) **Stabling:** 10X10 stalls are available. You may move in at noon on Friday. The show office will be open on Friday from 2pm-7pm and two hours before start of the show on Saturday. There is no security and overnight stays are at your own risk.
- 7) **Show Fees:** The following fees apply for the show, office fee is mandatory. All fees must be paid in full before the entry number is released.
  - a) Office fee -\$15 per horse and rider combination
  - b) Class fee -\$20 per class
  - c) Non member fee-\$15
  - d) Non compete fee-\$15
  - e) Late fee-\$15
  - f) Stall fee- \$45
  - g) Shavings- \$8/bag
  - h) Change fee- \$10
- 8) **Championship awards** will be presented to the horse/rider combination with the highest score at that level. This includes DDC member championship awards. It is the rider's responsibility to let show management know if they are a DDC member.
